CHIARA AGNELLO was born in Palermo and lives in Rome. After having attained an honors degree in a “History and criticism” in 1998 at the University of Study in Siena, she began working in the audiovisual industry covering a variety of roles in that field, always as part of the directing department. She has been working for years as a casting director for TV series and films. She has worked with directors such as Crialesse, Ando’, Soavi, Bellocchio, and has created casts for projects such as “Rocco Schiavone”, “Montalbano”, “Il Cacciatore”, “Skam” Italia and many others. He has shot several short films and commercials with social themes. He made his first documentary in 2015, “Prova Contraria”, which is based on the juvenile deviance and the difficult path of recovery of the minors of the Malaspina Institute in Palermo. “Prova Contraria” has participated in various festivals debuting at the Rome Film Festival. It has won several awards such as the “Salina Doc Festival” in 2017.
